The Government of Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the “Disaster and Climate Resilience Improvement Project (DCRIP)”, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for “Strengthening of River Training Works of Islam Head Works bringing to design parameters”.

2. The Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Punjab Irrigation Department, now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders through Single Stage Single Envelope Bidding Procedure for the Project located at upstream of Islam Headworks, District Vehari. The scope of works mainly consists of earthwork (including compaction, etc.) for strengthening of Right Retired Embankment (RRE), strengthening of Left Retired Embankment (LRE), Strengthening 2nd Defence Bund, Strengthening Murphy Spur, Stone pitching of Right Retired Embankment, Murphy Spur and Restoring G.H Spur by providing stone pitching and apron. Apron pit shall be excavated through excavator / drag lines to construct stone apron along the RRE and spurs. The total estimated earthwork is about 20 million cubic feet and Stone work is 4.25 million cubic feet. The Contractor shall be required to transport and supply about 4.25 million cubic feet of stone materials for the stone apron, stone pitching works, etc. The whole Project works shall be completed within limited period of 250 days. No margin of preference shall be applicable.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants, January 2011, Revised July 2014*, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

4. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Rs. 4,000/- (Rupees Four Thousand Only). The method of payment will be through cash deposit. The document can be collected from the office of the Project Director (PIU), Punjab Irrigation Department, House # 337-B, Canal View Housing Society, Near Thokar Niaz Beg, Lahore.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before December 06, 2016 (1330 hours). Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids (Technical & Financial) will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on December 06, 2016 (1400 hours).

7. All bids must be accompanied by a *Bid Security of about 8,700,000/- (Rupees Eight Million Seven Hundred Thousand Only)*.
